



Attorney Mentoring Program

NJ LEEP's College Bound Program partners with students to help them achieve their greatest college going ambitions. Our curriculum **combines law-related education programming with support and learning throughout the college application and access process.**

Sophomores and juniors participate in a Constitutional Law Program and two Constitutional Law Debate competitions held throughout the school year. Debates help our students develop critical thinking, writing/research skills, public speaking and confidence. Students submit a written brief and give oral arguments to panels of attorneys acting as judges.

Attorney mentors are paired with students 1:1 to help them prepare for each debate, including helping students understand the cases, develop their arguments, write their briefs, and prepare their oral presentations.

Mentors commit to supporting our students for at least one academic year from late September through May. Mentors have a tremendous impact on our students by providing support, motivation and modeling. Mentors are trained before being connected to a student and are supported throughout the year by NJ LEEP staff.
