POSITION OVERVIEW

NJ LEEP and Verizon seek exceptional law students for the 2024-2025 Verizon & NJ LEEP Fellowship. Fellows will work with NJ LEEP for 10 weeks during summer 2024 and with Verizon for the fall 2024 and spring 2025 semesters. Work with Verizon will be primarily remote with possible opportunities to work at Verizon Headquarters. This is a wonderful opportunity for a law student to learn about public interest law and corporate pro bono work. The Fellow will work directly with a Commercial Product Attorney who also supports Verizon's worldwide Pro Bono Program.

Summer 2024

The Fellows will coordinate and teach NJ LEEP's Summer Law Institute (SLI) which will take place in person for summer 2024 in Newark. SLI seeks to inspire motivated students from underserved communities entering high school to pursue careers in law and to strive for educational excellence. NJ LEEP students from Newark and surrounding communities matriculate into the Summer Law Institute. While enrolled, students engage with topics in criminal law, criminal procedure, and trial advocacy; guest speakers also provide students with insights into the legal landscape, and students attend field trips. The program culminates in a mock trial competition before sitting NJ judges.

The summer placement lasts from June 3rd to August 9th. Fellows will work directly with NJ LEEP's Legal Education Manager, who runs our law-related education programming. Fellows will prepare for SLI in June by participating in a training program that covers NJ LEEP's educational methodology and the development of lesson plans on substantive criminal law topics and trial advocacy skills. From July 1st to August 1st the Fellows will implement the five-week SLI and teach daily law-related lessons to approximately 40 rising 9th graders, fulfilling the objectives of the SLI through a set schedule of classes and events. In-person classes take place Monday-Thursday, with Friday serving as a remote instructional preparation day with no student programming.

Fall 2024 and Spring 2025

The Verizon Fellowship will include some initial training and onboarding with Verizon during summer 2024. During the fall and spring semesters, the Fellows will work with Verizon approximately one day (eight hours) a week. Most work will be done remotely with the opportunity to report to Verizon's New Jersey office on select days. This is a terrific opportunity for a law student to learn about pro bono law. Fellows will have the opportunity to work with Verizon attorneys to assist them with pro bono projects. As Verizon and NJ LEEP have programming together throughout the year, Fellows also may be asked by Verizon to work with and support NJ LEEP staff and students on various projects. 2024-2025 Fellows who are 1Ls will be encouraged to apply for Verizon's 2L summer internship program for summer 2025.

Compensation and Logistics

The Verizon & NJ LEEP Fellows will receive a stipend of \$13,750 for the year (\$750/week for the summer and \$6,250 for the year). 1Ls and 2Ls are encouraged to apply.

Interested applicants should complete an employment application <u>online</u> and follow directions in the application for submitting a resume and cover letter. Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply as soon as possible.
